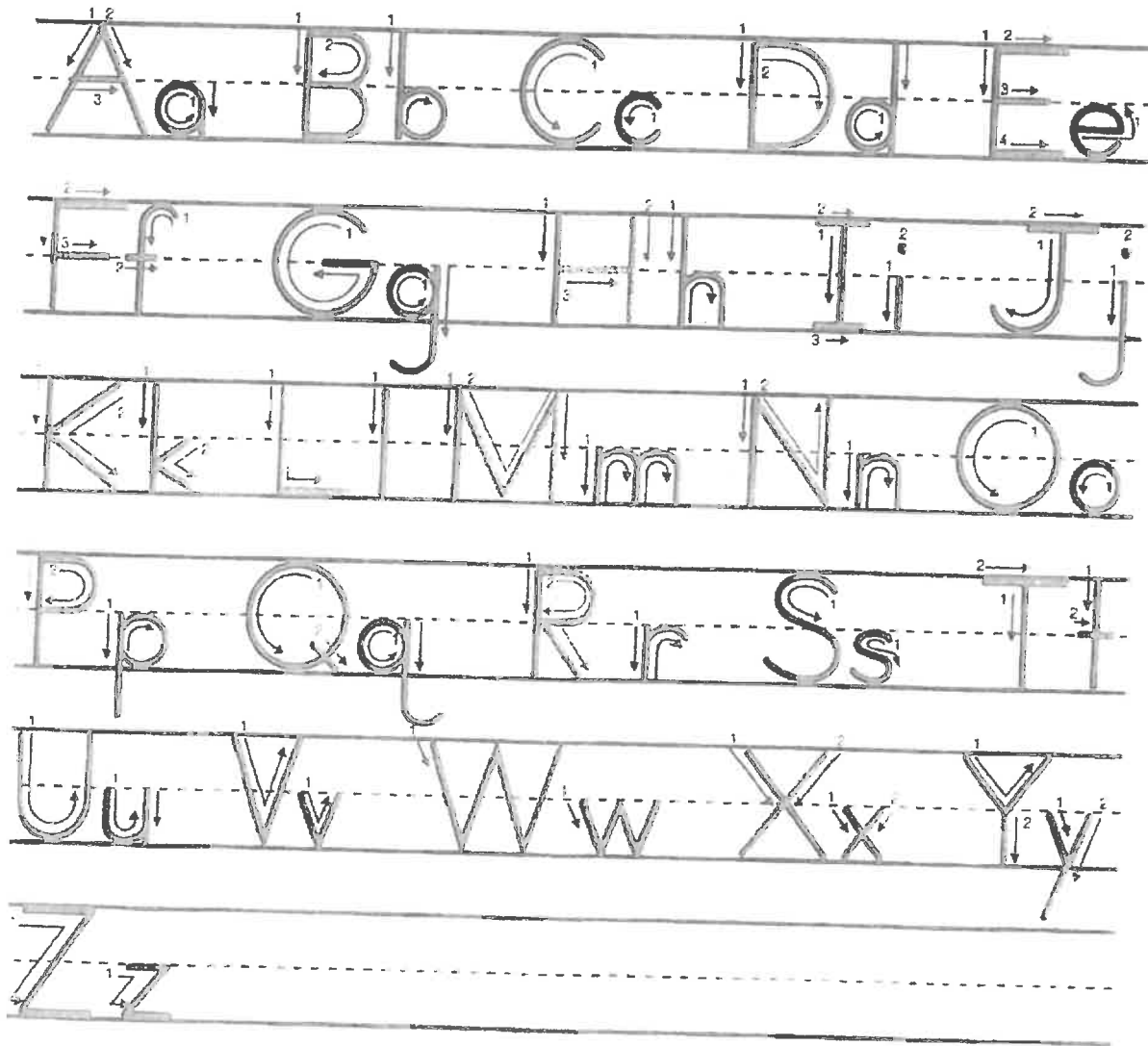

Use the letter strips on this page as guides for writing capital letters, lowercase letters, and words.

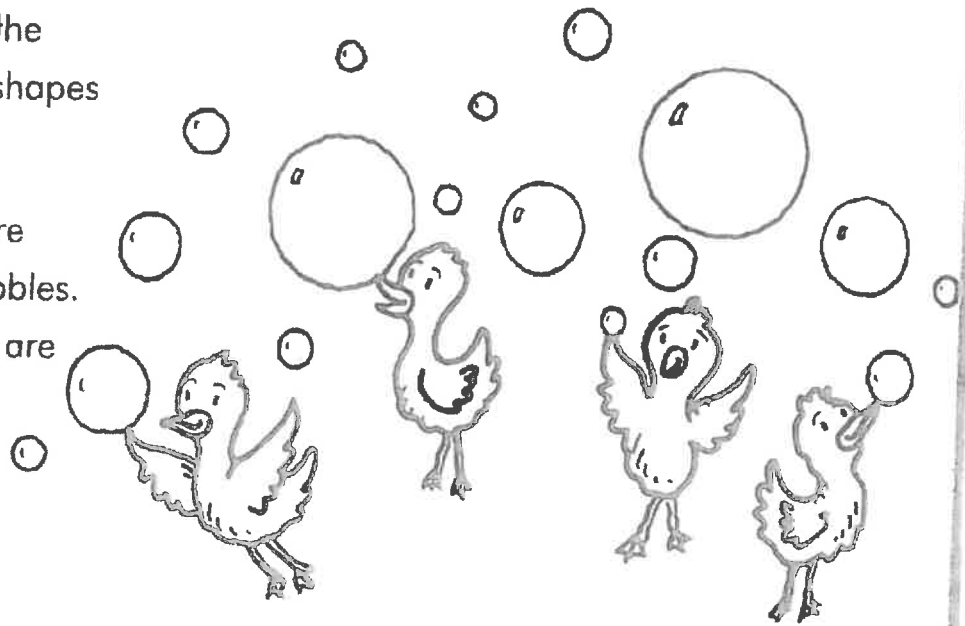

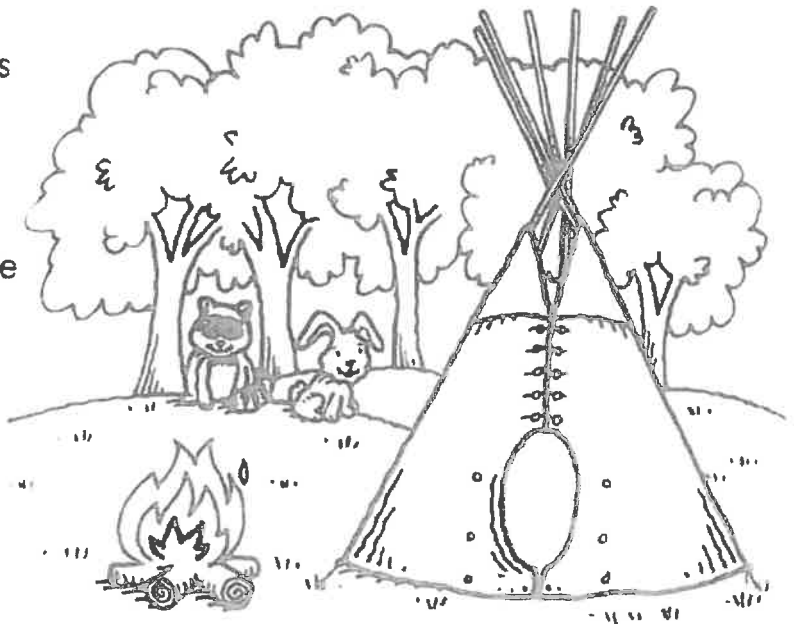
